OUR TIMES ARE IN GOD'S HAND

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 21 November 2021

Rethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of
Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
Time has flown us by so
quickly. Barely in five weeks, 2021
will fade into eternity past. The daily COVID19 update isn't rosy and future remain
uncertain. When we are informed loved
ones and friends come down with
infection, we inevitably become

uncomfortable and weary. Praise and thank God, thus far, Galilean are doing well. We continue to covet His mercy and protection.

Time!! Time is precious! We may not think much about time... except when we're running late and time is running out. Interestingly, as we mature in age, we give more thought to the issue of time, or rather how fast time is running out on us, and what we have done with the time given us. King David acknowledged: "My times are in Thy [God's] Hand" (Ps 31:15). Absolutely! The Creator God decides the length of our lives on Earth. Not COVID-19! However, what we do with the time that God has given us is our choice to make, a responsibility not to be taken lightly. for which we are accountable to God. When life on Earth ends, it is not how long we had lived that matters, but whether our life [long or short] had honoured God and impacted others for Christ. Are we living a life useful for God? Or living for self alone? The life [and time] that God has given us - are we investing for good things?

Let us treasure God's gift of life and use our God-given time for His glory and for His Kingdom's sake. We should not just spend time but invest it, not just "kill" time but redeem it. The best investment of our time is time with God — to build an intimate relationship with Him, to learn from Him and His Word, to grow spiritually, to serve Him, to bask in God's marvellous love and grace and celebrate our salvation with Christ our Saviour. I know we all have many commitments but we must make time to prayerfully do a self-examination of how we are doing in the Lord and with His time. And brethren, in this process of self-examination, let's call a spade a spade, a failure a failure, a wrong a wrong, and a sin


a sin. Acknowledge our faults and failures, confess them, repent and get back on track again. If not, we will just be still carrying our many "baggages" of the past, our unrighteous habits and sloppy lifestyle, and wasting away yet another year of our lives.

Honestly, we do not know about tomorrow but we know the God Who controls our tomorrow, and we know He holds our hands. Even as David poured his heart out to

God, he also put his faith to look up to God: "But I trust in Thee, O LORD; I said, "Thou art my God."
David turned to God for renewal, and restoration. Our times are fixed by our sovereign God. It is God's prerogative to settle all things that concern us. Life and death, times of plenty, of adversity, of joy and sorrow... they are all of God's ordering. It is for God to rule, and for us to trust and obey.

The Good Shepherd takes care of and provides for His own, the sheep of His pasture. Don't ever entertain the thought, when under certain duress, that God has forgotten us. He never forsakes His people. What a privilege and blessing it is for us to receive the Benediction after Sunday Worship Service: "The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The LORD lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace" (Num 6:24-26). Wow! The God Who is able to do so much more than we can ask or imagine, has chosen to turn His favour upon us. What more can we ask for? What ought to be our response? With grateful hearts and in humble adoration and worship, we look up to Father God for we know we can trust Him for our future -- both on earth and for eternity.

Let us pray for a spiritual revival in our Church, a holy fire burning for His glory, bringing His marvelous Light to a dark and fallen world. Indeed, our times are in God's Hand. We are not masters of our destiny but we can place all our trust in our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. With the life[and time] that God has given us, let us dedicate it for the service of the King of kings and Lord of lords, wherever the Lord has placed us.
