

TRIUMPHANT IN CHRIST Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 9 April 2023

eloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. During this Easter season, it is an opportune time for us to reflect on what Jesus went through for our sakes: the humiliation during His false trial, the pain of His crucifixion and death on the Cross for our sins, being buried for 3 days in the tomb, but finally resurrecting from the dead! What should our response be?

What Jesus did for us ensures that we always have the full and complete victory in Him (2 Cor. 2:14a "Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ..."). We are not to live our Chrisitan life in a defeated manner, allowing the numerous challenges in our lives to overwhelm us. Instead, we are to overcome them with Christ in us as "we are more than conquerors through Him (Romans 8:38-39). However, this means that we need to be "in Christ" to have a part in this full and compete victory.

What does it mean to be "in Christ"? To be "in Christ" means to have a close, intimate and living relationship with Him. In doing so, John 15:4-5 shows us that if we do not abide in Christ, we cannot accomplish anything for Him. We also need to take full control of our thoughts such that they do not bring us to a point where we exalt ourselves against the knowledge of God (2 Cor. 10:5). This can only be done when we rely, not on ourselves, but on the spiritual weapons that God has provided for us, through His Word and prayer (2 Cor. 10:4; Heb. 4:12; Col. 4:2-4).

What then are the fruits or signs of a triumphant life in Christ? First, our lives need to be fully surrendered to Him and seeing it as an act of worship to God. Fully surrendering to Christ means that we are prepared to commit ourselves to follow His leading even through the most puzzling, difficult and trying times in our lives (Gal. 2:20). We must thus realise that God's perspective, thoughts, and ways are always higher and better than our mere human ones (Isaiah 55:8-9 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, saith the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts").

We who experience triumph and victory in Christ should also not keep it to ourselves, but should share it in a bold and generous manner such that the savour of His knowledge are made manifest or clear in every place (2 Cor. 2:14b). We should be motivated to do this in gratitude for the great price that Christ paid on the Cross for our sins. This can be done in 2 main ways: 1. In our daily living, we are able to bear through our sufferings in such a way that others can see Christ and His strength in us; 2. As we speak forth or share Christ to others around us. it is unto God a sweet savour (2 Cor. 2:15). No matter what the response of persons regarding our sharing with them, whether it be accepted as "a savour of life unto life" or rejected as "a savour of death unto death" (2 Cor. 2:16a), we still need to remain faithful in doing so (Mark 16:15-16).

May we during this season of Easter reflect and mediate on the words of the chorus of the hymn *"Victory in Jesus"* and have the confidence that we are all triumphant in Christ!

Oh, victory in Jesus, my Savior forever. He sought me and bought me with His redeeming blood. He loved me 'ere I knew Him, and all my love is due Him. He plunged me to victory beneath the cleansing flood!
