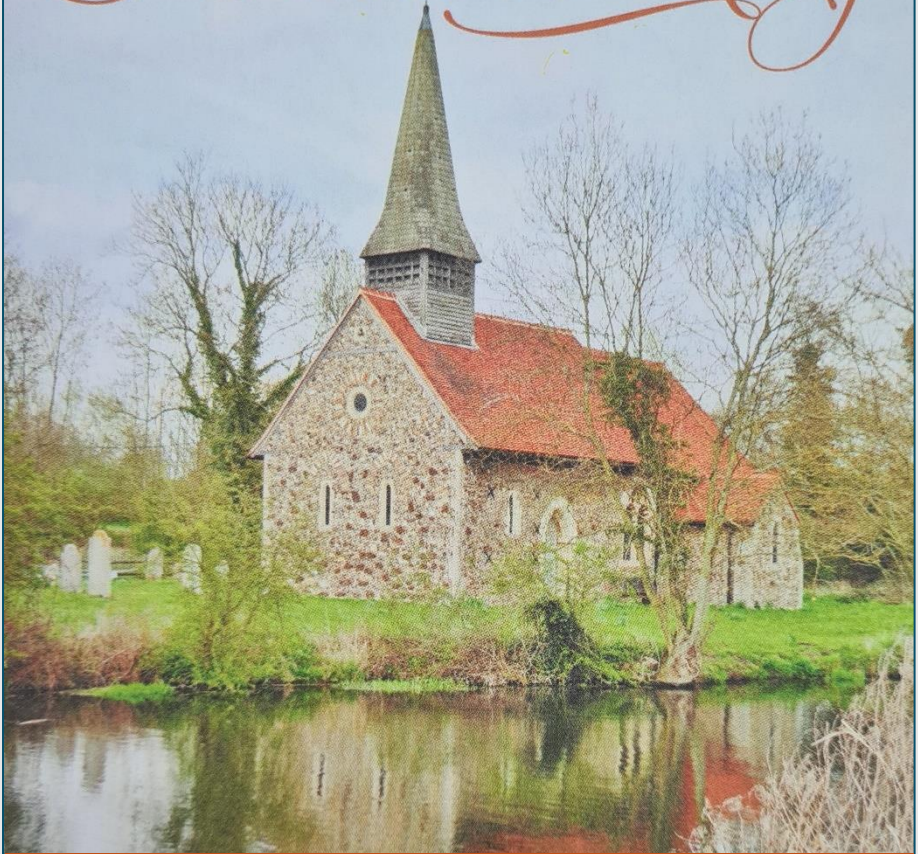



CONSTITUTION OF THE GALILEE B-P CHURCH

ELECTION TO THE CHURCH SESSION

ARTICLE 15 Qualifications for Elders

Titus 1:6-9

⁶If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly. ⁷For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not self-willed, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; ⁸But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate; ⁹Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.

1 Peter 5:1-5

¹The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed: ²Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind; ³Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock. ⁴And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away. ⁵Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. [*See also: 1 Tim 3:1-7; Acts 20:28*]

Article 16 Qualifications for Deacons & Deaconesses

1 Tim 3:8-13

⁸Likewise must the deacons be grave, not double-tongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre; ⁹Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience. ¹⁰And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being found blameless. ¹¹Even so must their wives be grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things. ¹²Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well. ¹³For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

The Lord Is Marvellously Good! *Pastor Simon*

Brethren,
Galilee Anniversary Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! On a day like this, there aren't enough words in us to praise God for all His goodness and mercies on His church. We marvel at how God has gladly and patiently journeyed with us for such a long time. Sixty-four years! The Lord has given us plenty of reasons to sing praises to Him, knees bow in grateful worship, and hearts to serve exuberantly the Head of the Church, our Lord, and Master Jesus Christ. Truly, "For the Lord is good: His mercy is everlasting; and His truth endureth to all generations." Ps 100:5.

On this day, we reflect on how the Lord has delivered us from spiritual darkness, leading each one of us responsibly towards our "promised land." Our predecessors have scaled the mountains, walked the valley, encountered challenging uncertainties, and experienced seasons of celebrations and accomplishment.
