The High Calling Of Motherhood Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 12 May 2024

eloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Today, we celebrate Mother's Day on which we honour and are reminded not to overlook the important role that mothers play in our families. Both fathers and mothers are given the divine calling from God to holistically care for the children under their stewardship and care. This holistic and nurturing care not only refers to the physical aspects, but also meeting their spiritual, social, mental and emotional needs (Luke 2:52 "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man").

This tendency to focus merely on the physical and academic areas is reinforced by the intensity and stress placed by the local Singapore education system despite efforts to minimise it. Such an emphasis is also reflected in our lives as parents, as we busy ourselves and fill our schedules with work, family and other commitments. It is a dire fact of life that our energies are drained, and our emotions are frayed when we get back to our families at the end of the day (Eph. 6:4 "And, ve fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord"). As such, the pressures and stresses of our daily lives would inevitably cause us to lose our focus and goal of being disciple-makers of our children.

We parents (both fathers and mothers) must always remind ourselves that the spiritual upbringing of our children is God's calling for us. This means that we should not think that the weekly Sunday School class is of itself sufficient for such spiritual upbringing, but know that it supplements and builds upon our daily interaction and teaching of our children. Such teaching is not only verbal, but also practical as our children see how we respond to immediate and sudden crises that come about, by praying and turning to God for His help and guidance (Matt. 6:33 "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you"). As we build strong marriages and families, it would form the building blocks of both society and church.

The specific role of mothers in our families is to be the helpmate that complements our husbands accordingly (Gen. 2:18 "And the Lord God said. It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him"). As the husband provides loving leadership for his family (Eph. 5:23), the wife is to support and aid him throughout the whole process (Eph. 5:22). With the contribution of both parents, the instructive, and caring and compassionate aspects would be provided for and experienced by the children (Isaiah 66:13 "As one whom his mother comforteth, so will I comfort you; and ye shall be comforted in Jerusalem"). We are also to remind one another that our focus and attention should not be on the present and temporal things of this world. Instead, we must train and develop the spiritual character of our children in preparation for what the future holds for them (Prov. 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it").

May God grant His wisdom and grace to us as parents to fulfil our high calling as disciple-makers in His Kingdom Work among our children. God bless all mothers, mothers-to-be, grandmothers, and great-grandmothers in Galilee Church as we celebrate this important occasion this morning!
