Faithful Steward

ear brothers and sisters, "Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ".

In view of the coming election of elders, deacons and deaconesses, I would like to remind us of the profound calling to serve the Lord Jesus Christ, the Head of the Church. Please be reminded that we are not serving the church of Galilee or fulfilling a duty of the positions but our service is unto our Master and Lord Jesus Christ!

On our part, there must be dedication and commitment to the task as elected to the positions. Therefore, what is required of the Lord? "Moreover, it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful" (1 Cor. 4:2). Whether or not we have been called as minister of God's truth, as our Lord's servants we all have been given some stewardship from the Lord. Therefore, the fundamental principle of stewardship stands for us all – Faithfulness, is required. What does it mean to be such a servant and steward of the Lord our God?

A steward simply has the assignment to manage the household for the head of that household or to manage the material possessions for the. Brethren, this is the reality of our stewardship before the Lord our God. We are not the head. God our heavenly Father is the Head of His household; and God the Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, is the Head of His church. We are the servants of God the Father and of Jesus Christ our Lord. We are not the owners. God the Father and God the Son, in the oneness of the eternal Godhead, is the Owner. We serve as stewards of His possessions.

Moreover, we must make that commitment because we have been bought with a price. Paul said, "You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore, honour God with your body" (1 Cor. 6:19-20). We're no more belong to ourselves, and we must "offer your bodies as living sacrifices,

holy and pleasing to God" (Rom. 12:1). We must synchronise with Paul, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me" (Gal. 2:20). We are all indebted to Christ, what can we claim for ourselves?

Faithfulness is our Lord's requirement for our stewardship. There is no greater privilege today for Christian than to be known and remembered as a faithful servant of Jesus Christ. Our aim is neither to covet a position nor gain ("Got money I serve, no money I don't"). Let this thought and attitude perish as we serve the Lord.

The first mark of faithfulness is accountability! All of us as Christians are going to be held accountable. Who are you and I be accountable to? Our text tells us, "It is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful." As faithful servants, we are to be accountable to God. You are accountable for what you do! Everything we do or don't do - we are accountable for. You see, being a faithful servant and a faithful steward begins with accountability. Reward from God - We are going to be rewarded for faithful service, not that we have no reward for selfless dedication in the Lord's work. What do you most like to hear from the Lord? Let me remind us of Matthew 25:21. Our Lord Jesus Christ proclaimed, "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things...enter thou into the joy of thy Lord".

Faithfulness is our Lord's standard for our stewardship. The question before us is this – at the judgment seat of Christ, will you be found faithful? Will our Lord be able to commend us as good and faithful servants? Are we, right now, faithfully doing that which the Lord our God has assigned for us to do?
