# Keeping On The Fire For God

*Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 14 July 2024*

**B**eloved Brethren,  
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Ephesians 2:8-9 reminds us that we all have been graciously saved by God in Christ alone, and not based on our human goodness, works, and achievements (accomplishments). Being conscious of God's gracious salvation, we are not to become too comfortable and complacent regarding our Christian faith. In addition, Eph 2:10 goes on to remind us that we are indeed God's workmanship or masterpiece. Knowing this, we must be prepared to accept and submit to God and His moulding or shaping process including those of adversity and challenges. Throughout this whole process, we are to be confident and assured of God's plan and purposes for our lives.

As a physical fire needs the supply of firewood as well as oxygen to keep itself burning and not being extinguished, how can we then keep our lives aligned to and burning on for God? The foundational fuel that is needed for our spiritual living is simply our abiding and sustaining relationship and love of and for God (John 15:5). When we do not have this continuing relationship and love for God remaining in our lives, we will surely be in danger of losing our first love for Him and becoming lukewarm in our Christian faith even while we are actively serving and doing different things for Him.

This same visual picture of a strongly burning fire is that of a group or bunch of firewood. We would never see a single or lone firewood sustaining or remaining on fire on its own. As followers of Christ, we would also need the loving and supportive environment of our fellow Christians to keep ourselves going for God. Heb. 10:24-25 reminds us to not neglect and overlook this

important aspect of Christian community and fellowship in our Christian walk. When we are actively involved in the Christian community, we are properly strengthened and supported, especially in our times of weakness and struggles (Eccl. 4:9-12).

When we come to the point of becoming inattentive to our spiritual condition or state, we are exposed to the great danger of spiritual drifting in the strong currents of the world's values and principles. Such spiritual drifting would not be very obvious initially, but over some time, it would become a very slippery slope in which we find our spiritual values compromised. It is only then that we realise we have drifted far from God and are rudely awakened in such a state.

Let us also keep ourselves burning on in our service for Him (Romans 12:11 "Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord"). God, through His Holy Spirit, has surely given us different gifts, talents, and strengths through which we can serve and contribute to the effective functioning of the Body of Christ, the Church. Let every one of us not allow our spiritual gifts to linger unused or our minds to be filled with imaginations or ideas that our contributions would be meaningless or insignificant. If we can put our full attention and effort into our families and jobs, how much more should we put into our spiritual serving in church? As such, we should develop a participant and not a spectator mentality regarding our spiritual serving.

Let us "hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for He is faithful that promised:)" (Heb. 10:23).
