## **Our Faithful Service For God**

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 28 July 2024

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of
our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
Today is Church General Elections Day
which happens every 3 years. Please commit
the election proceedings that will happen later
into God's Hand and may every church
member fulfil your duty and responsibility to
prayerfully put forth your vote.

But not only does God want His church officers serving in the different portfolios of the church ministries and departments, He also wants all of you as church members to actively serve and contribute through your different spiritual gifts and talents. We must thus overcome the wrong thinking and misconception that God only uses the very gifted and talented to serve Him. We must instead remind ourselves that He is open and willing to use even so-called ordinary people from all corners of the congregation regardless of social and economic standing.

We can look at 3 such examples from the Bible. First is the example of Noah who wholeheartedly obeyed and followed when God instructed him to build the ark (Gen. 6:22), even when it seemed ridiculous and foolish during the time of no rain. Second is the example of Moses who admitted that "O my Lord, I am not eloquent" (Ex. 4:10), but God still used him to stand before Pharoah and lead the people of Israel out of the land of Egypt. Third is the example of Gideon who was the son of a poor farmer living during the time the Midianites oppressed Israel. Though Gideon admitted and thought of himself that "wherewith (how) shall I save Israel? Behold, my family is poor in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house" (Judges 6:15), God still used him as Israel's deliverer from the Midianites.

What are the important attitudes that we all must have in our serving?

One, we must be living holy lives that bring glory and honour to His name. It is only when we live such holy lives that God can use us (2 Tim. 2:21b "... he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the Master's use"). In contrast, having sin in our lives will surely result in us being cut off from God and Him using us to do His Work (Isaiah 59:1-2).

Two, we must have humility in our hearts. We must have harbour and allow pride to fester and grow in our hearts, regarding our status in society, our education and degrees, and even our gifts and talents. We must remind ourselves that all of them, and even our lives, come from God. Thus, knowing this, we are to use them especially in the context of sacrificial service (Phil. 3:7-8).

Three, we need to have the willingness and readiness to be used by God. If any person is gifted and talented but is not willing to be used by God, God cannot use this person. Thus, we need to develop hearts that are willing and have the desire to be used by God in whatever way and manner He desires to (2 Chron. 16:9a "... whose heart is perfect toward").

Four, is that our service for God needs to be faithful and firm, and not waver especially during seasons of difficulty, discouragement, and distraction. Such faithful service would be blessed and rewarded by God's commendation (Matt. 5:21, 23).

Let us be instruments set aside for God and His righteous use and service (Rom. 6:13).
