Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! The prophet Isaiah proclaims, "He shall feed His flock like a shepherd: He shall gather the lambs with His arm, and carry them in His bosom. and shall gently lead those that are with young." Isaiah 40:11. Immediately, we could read the strong relational pulse between the shepherd and the sheep. First, our Lord sensitively, carefully, sufficiently, and timely provides for our physical needs. David writes, "The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing" Ps 34:10. Dismiss all worries both for our lives and the church.
