



#### Avid Learners Of God's Word

eloved Brethren. our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. The ministering to. late Howard G. Hendricks who was a famous Christian professor and educator once said, "Leaders are readers, and readers are leaders". What this means is that we, who are leaders and teachers and by extension the rest of us, need to have our hearts always open to learning and developing. Not only does this attitude toward learning, unlearning, relearning apply at any isolated moment, but it must also be extended to our whole lifetime. This concept of never-ending lifelong learning is also encapsulated in the all-familiar term of discipleship.

No matter what each of our learning styles is, it all boils down to our love for studying and digging God's Word. Such into opportunities and times should not be restricted only to our private time but should also be extended to seizing and taking full advantage of the various group learning platforms primarily in church and secondarily, elsewhere too. This is because we can then learn from others, and also expose any blind spots in our theological or biblical understanding. Thereafter, such depth in God's Word is not only seen in our intellectual or theoretical knowledge but is shown in our love for God and others, especially in our works of service (Gal. 6:9-10). All of these are reflective of our active obedience and not the mere passive listening to God's Word (James 1:23-24).

Our love for God and His Word should not be kept to ourselves, but also overflow into the lives of others (2 Tim. 2:2). As Dr. Hendricks also said "He [God] calls you to teach people the Bible". As such, we must not only seek to dig deep to understand more thoroughly God's Word, but God bless!

To teach others our in-depth study of God's Word would result in our own spiritual learning and growth. Such knowledge can be appropriately and adequately passed on to others by using a wide range of avenues and pathways such as using personal and applicable stories (parables). object lessons, open-ended questions, and paradoxes [interesting bridges of understanding] to spark and maintain interest. This teaching and learning process could then continue through the lives of our students and their students and so on.

The learning process regarding God's Word should also not be restricted to people within the church, but also those in society and outside of the church. The well-known Great Commission passage from Matt. 28:18-20 "Then Jesus came to them and said... "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations... Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you..." teaches us the 2 important emphases of first evangelism and second, discipleship.

May our SSGs [Small Support Groups] be vehicles to, not only minister and build up our people but also provide the content [appropriate Bible Study topics] and means [the different creative outreach social programs] to reach out to people from our various social circles. We are thus to reach out attractionally and not just wait for our main church evangelistic events.
