





rethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Life has its defining moments and critical crossroads along the way. There are times we decide our direction without many choices given. In challenging times especially, how do we know we are making the right choice and getting on the right path?

Believers, the only right way to go is the way of the Lord. When we stand at the crossroads of life, we must first seek God and be guided by His Word. The Bible is the storehouse of invaluable insight and wisdom. It contains the whole counsel of God. applicable to every situation in life. Imagine, driving at night, on a dark rural road with the headlights turned off that could result in disaster. We have a choice whether to go by what is convenient, and pragmatic and by one's experience to formulate a solution. Everyone out there does that. But as Christians, we work our situation in the light of the Scriptures which may not be expedient, even practical, nor sits well with the wisdom of the world. Nevertheless, living life without the application of the blessed Word of God is unwise. "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path" (Ps 119:105).

Making life choices without God's guidance has dire consequences. If we chart a path that is not in line with the Word, we are assuredly "courting" with trouble. God's Word reveals God's Will!

But what happens if we don't seem to be able to find a specific and direct answer from the Bible to help us decide? For instance, when faced with a decision to buy or rent a house, will we find a "thou shalt not rent, or thou shalt buy" in the Bible? Probably not! So, what then can we do? God invites us to prayer. "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him" (James 1:5). Praying to God for wisdom and searching for

direction from His Word must go together. We don't know everything, but our omniscient God would guide us in any situation. When you don't know what to do, pray! Often, we are quick to do things our way in pursuit of instant solutions and quick fixes instead of waiting upon the Lord in prayer. Impatience impairs otherwise a possible good outcome. "A man's heart deviseth his way: but the Lord directeth his steps." Prov 16:9. The discipline of prayer creates greater dependence and confidence in the Lord and restore calmness and peace in uncertain times. The Holy Spirit indwells in us, illuminates our minds, instructs our hearts, and aids our memory with relevant Scriptures, to know and access situations soundly to avoid the "debris" of bad decisions

Last but not least, praise and thank God for a community of believers like Pastors, Elders, church leaders and mature fellow Christians to walk alongside and guide and help us "figure out" confronting situations in accordance with God's Will. The church has the responsibility before God to care for the brethren. "Bear ye one another's burdens..." (Gal 6:2). Here again, I must underline the crucial role the SSG ministry (which we will further refine) could play in the lives of our people. Within a small circle of brethren, confidently, we can express our fears and concerns seek prayer support and receive their wise counsel to help along. The slogan is share, care and bear! Let's caringly listen to each other's struggles, pray, and seek God's Word together to discern the unique aspects of each situation and apply the biblically informed wisdom to the issues. God's way is the best.

Brethren, Christians are a very blessed people. We should fare better than anyone out there in the world. With God's unconditional love and care, His precious Word and the support of believers we will cope with our earthly challenges much better than others. God Bless!
