



Bridging Generations Through Mentoring

eloved Brethren. Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Christ Himself mentioned in Luke 18:16-17 "But Jesus called them unto him, and said. Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not; for of such is the kingdom of God. Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child shall in no wise enter therein." What does Christ mean by having a childlike heart? He means that we must have a heart that is teachable, and not think that we have gained enough knowledge, especially spiritual knowledge. Such a teachable heart would surely help us to navigate through life and its issues. Our learning is thus a lifelong process that never stops and applies to every single person in our midst, regardless of age and position in the church congregation, whether as a church leader or an ordinary church member or friend. What is important for each of us is our desire to learn and grow in our spiritual walk with God.

We would stop growing spiritually when we think we have acquired enough knowledge and experience in ourselves to go through life. As such, we must first open our hearts to be willing to learn and grow. Secondly, we should look forward to being involved in this meaningful process of mentoring whether as a mentor or a mentee. Thirdly, both the mentor and the mentee need to properly understand what is really involved in the process of mentoring to effectively carry it out.

In a mentor-mentee relationship, both must have the desire to learn from and grow together in their walk with God (Eph. 4:15 "But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ"). The mentor supports God Bless!

and encourages the mentee in the things and areas that he is doing well. But the mentor also challenges and pushes the mentee to improve in his weak areas as well as to step out of his comfort zones to attempt and do greater things for God. Of course, undergirding all of these must be the mutual trust and respect which would result in the openness of life and sharing that the mentor and mentee would have toward one another

But we cannot ignore and escape the time commitment aspect of mentoring. There is both the structured regular time of mentor-mentee meetings as well as the additional spontaneous times of walking with the mentee in his times of struggles and need. In addition, we, who are living in a fast-paced and competitive modern society in Singapore, also tend to have our focus and attention taken away from the spiritual by many other attractive worldly options and alternatives. We must thus intentionally and consciously put forth mentoring as our utmost priority, knowing the effort and sacrifices involved in it (1 Tim. 4:8 "For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come").

As we think of how this concept of mentoring and discipleship can be brought into our lives, may we be always reminded of the 2 greatest commandments for us: to love God and to love one another May we press forward together as one united spiritual body with mutual love and concern for one another, worshipping and serving together.
