Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 6 October 2024

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Christians are God's handiwork exhibited to catch the attention of the world. Watching us, the world may be persuaded to "buy into our faith" in Christ Jesus. Here, my mind goes to the episode in the Book of Job where God said to the Devil: "Hast thou considered My servant Job? For there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and turneth away from evil" (Job 1:8;1:1).

Wow, what a testimonial from God for His servant Job. Do you think for any of us the Lord would vouch in the same manner and by the same words? An honest self-examination will quickly give away the answer. How can anyone ever measure up to such lofty expectations from the Almighty? Our thoughts, imaginations, words and actions often lack the purity that God expects of us. Though, we are no longer slaves to sin, (Romans 6:6,14) sin still roams and roams in our beings and registers its presence from time to time. Hence, it has become our daily prayer practice to humbly confess our sins before God, seeks His forgiveness (1 John 1:9), strive to do better and walk closer to Jesus our Lord.

Well, dispel the gloom and praise the Lord for we are righteous in Christ Jesus. He has imputed His righteousness on us (2 Cor 5:21). Hence, we are reconciled with God and the Holy Spirit resides in us. Next, our Lord is graciously doing a sanctification work in us (1 Pet 1:2) as we mature in the Scriptures (Jhn 17:17) to rightly reflect Christ through us to a broken world.

Going back to Job, God desires to groom a servant after His own heart, to conform him to the image of His beloved Son, our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. A servant who loves God and who eagerly does His Will. A servant who faithfully dedicates resources, strength and energy to obey and serve God till his last breath! The question we need to ask is: "Whose

servant, am I?" It is possible for a believer to serve GOD part-time, but SELF and the WORLD, full-time. We need to diligently fix this spiritual condition and remain vigilant.

Next, God described Job as unique — there was "none like him". Indeed, you and I are unique as well. Each of us is inimitable and exclusive to the Lord. Peter writes, "But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light" (1 Peter 2:9). We are God's precious people and His dearest servants. What an honour and privilege bestowed on us! Let's treasure it and press on in our service to God. The best is yet to be!

Next, let's look at some servant attributes in Job: God described him as perfect and upright. The word "perfect" does not mean flawless or sinless. Certainly not! Every man born into the lineage of Adam is imperfect and sinful. So was Job. But what pleased God was that Job was a man who did what was right in the sight of God. He carried in him a sensitive conscience and a Godward heart. Let's ask God to help us cultivate this inward sanctity in us. God commended Job as one who feared God and shunned away from evil. Such discipline must govern and guide the choices we make in our daily lives (Psalm 1:1-2). We read in the Bible that Job ordered his personal life, his family life, his business dealings, social activities and communal responsibilities in ways that are consistent with the teaching of God's Word. This is Christ-centred life! God helping us, let's strive to be on higher ground spiritually and lovingly submit to the Lordship of Christ as He continues His sanctifying work in us. We are all "Work In Progress," being transformed daily to be well-pleasing to God. We press on, and do well, by His Grace!
