### **Christmas, To Worship Him!**

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 1 December 2024

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Christmas is upon us again! A season permeating in fellowship and love. A time when family members gather around for special meals and express love and appreciation in the exchange of well-thought-out gifts. While carols and hymns play in the background.

What is the true spirit of Christmas? Is it fellowship? Is it giving? Is it fun? Is it good food? For us believers, Christmas brings a whole new meaning to our lives. Christmas is the profound truth of God expressing His great love and mercy for a lost mankind! God sent His beloved Son, our dear Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, to come down from Heaven to dwell amongst man, and to die on the Cross, as redemption for man's sin. The true spirit of Christmas is recorded in the Holy Scriptures. Chapters one and two of the Gospel of Luke account for us.

Let's start with Elisabeth. On meeting cousin Mary, we read that Elisabeth "was filled with the Holy Ghost: And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou [Mary] among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb" (1:41,42). Next, we move to the realm of the angels (Lk 2:13). The angelic hosts rejoiced in praise and worship, announcing the Birth of Baby Jesus, the New-born King. Then, the shepherds, having found Mary and the Babe, glorified and praised God "for all that they had heard and seen, as it was told to them" (v.20). Next, we visit the temple where Simeon who waited "for the consolation of Israel... and it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ" (vs. 25,26). Simeon took Baby Jesus into his arms and "blessed God" (v.28). He prayed: "Lord, now lettest Thou Thy servant depart in peace, according to Thy Word: For mine eyes have seen Thy salvation" (vs.29,30). "Then Anna the prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel came in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of Him to all them that looked for redemption to Jerusalem" (v.38).

Elisabeth, the angels, the shepherds, Simeon and Anna had one response in common towards Christmas. They praised God and worshipped Him and declared the Lord Jesus Christ to the world. The spirit of that very first Christmas was praise and thanks, blessing and glory to God. To sum it all up into one word, it is "WORSHIP". Matt 2:2 tells us that the Wise Men came from the East to seek Baby Jesus with one purpose: "We are come to worship Him". Even wicked King Herod seemed to have caught the spirit of this glorious event -- despite lying about his objective to find Baby Jesus. For all that it is worth. Herod instructed the Wise Men: "Go and search diligently for the young Child; and when ye have found Him, bring me word again, that I may come and worship Him also" (v.8).

Dear brethren, WORSHIP is the true spirit of Christmas. Heartfelt worship in praise, adoration and thanks to the Almighty God is how Christians ought to celebrate the Birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ at Christmas. This time of all times is a time of worship. Worship is an attitude of our hearts that overflow with awesome wonder, praise and gratitude toward God for all that He has done for mankind, unworthy as we are. Worship is surrendering ourselves totally to God, in praise and adoration: "Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His Holy Name" (Ps 103:1).

Brethren, the crowning activity is WORSHIP. Worship that comes from deep within our hearts and souls; Worship that is directed toward our Maker and Creator of Heaven and earth, the Almighty, all-powerful God, and our Saving Lord. Worship acknowledges the faithful God Who keeps every promise to us, His people. God bless!
