# We will be Alright!

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day 3 November 2024

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ! Life has its defining
moments and key crossroads along the way.
There are times when we consciously choose our
destination, and times we are not given any
choice. In challenging times how do we know we
are making the right choice and going along the
right path?

For the Christians, the only right way to go is the way of the Lord. When we stand at the crossroads of life, the first thing we must do is to seek God and be guided by His Word. The Bible contains the whole counsel of God, applicable to all situations in life. Living life without the blessed illumination of the Word of God is unwise. "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path" (Ps 119:105). Making life choices without God's quidance has dire consequences. Many things in life aren't 100% guaranteed but I can assure you 100% that if we chart a path that is not in line with the teachings of the Bible, we are assuredly "courting" with trouble. Scripture warns. "There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof is the ways of death" Prov 14:12.

But what happens if we don't seem to be able to find a direct answer from the Bible to help us in deciding? For instance, when faced with a decision to buy or rent a house, will we find a "thou shalt not rent, thou shalt buy" in the Bible? Probably not! So, what then can we do? God invites us to pray. "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally... James 1:5). Praying to God for wisdom and searching for direction from His Word must go in tandem. We don't know everything. But our omniscient God knows everything. Often, we are quick to fabricate instant solutions and quick fixes instead of exercising faith and patience in prayer. God invites us to "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and he will make your paths straight" Prov 3:5-6.

Next, God's children have the Holy Spirit to lead us through the maze of life. "For as many as are <u>led by the Spirit of God</u>, they are the sons of God" (Rom 8:14). Our good Lord has given us the Holy Spirit to lead and guide us, quickening our minds to assess the situation correctly in the light of the Scriptures. Hence, we are steady in rough times!

Furthermore, we can evaluate matters whether right or wrong with the help of our regenerated conscience in Christ. Conscience is an internal mechanism that God implanted in us with which we judge our own thoughts, words and actions, either condemning or approving them. However, we have to be careful here! Because of our sinful nature, our conscience can give us faulty readings which lead us to make decisions seemingly correct in our eyes but contrary to the precepts of God. We are capable of conditioning our conscience by our life experiences, norms of the community and cultural influences. Moreover, we need also to truly examine our motives! The motives of the heart have a powerful influence on our conscience.

Finally, the Lord has blessed us with Pastors, Elders, and mature brothers and sisters in Christ. They are willing to walk alongside us to guide us in life's challenges. The Word of God calls us to "Bear ye one another's burdens." (Gal 6:2). This is where I pray, that the Small Support Group (SSG) ministry will play a crucial role in our midst.

Brethren, with the help of God's Word, the ministry of the Holy Spirit, fellow believers and a faithful Saviour Jesus Christ, all of us can be victors in Christ even in this life. We are blessed with many resources to help us cope with our earthly life challenges. Let's be a "working lighthouse" to help fellow brethren and share our care, love and benevolence cheerfully. By His grace and to His glory we will do our best to be a blessing to one another and prevail together. Amen!
