# Christmas, Not An After Thought!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 15 December 2024

rethren,

Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Streets are glittering with festive lights, malls are crowded with shoppers and diners. Even our neighbourhood supermarkets stream carols to greet their customers. Families planning excitedly their Christmas gatherings where heartfelt sharing of God's goodness adds meaning and flavour to the conversation as they catch up with one another over sumptuous meals. Needless to say, Churches everywhere are at their peak in ushering in the most joyous season of the year. We too have done well with our church!

Our Lord Jesus Christ is the crucial reason for Christmas. Without Christ, we have no Christmas, and doing Christmas without Christ is the recipe for the Lost. The Scriptures say, "But when the <u>fulness of the</u> time was come, <u>God sent forth His Son</u>, made of a woman, made under the law, <u>To redeem</u> them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons." Gal 4:4-5.

I used to wonder what if Christ was born in our time, with the help of the internet, and social media the Gospel would have reached the entire world within a fraction of the time. Are we wiser than God framed with our limited knowledge and wisdom? First, we take note of "the fullness of time," which is God's <u>predetermined time</u> in human history to reveal His only begotten Son, our Saviour in the flesh. Since the mention of a Saviour in Gen 3:15, the prophecy was fulfilled when Christ was born on this earth (Lk 2:11). On a lesser scale perhaps, we realise that we too live our lives by the ticking of time. God will bring about His will in our lives according to His time (Ecc 3:1a). He is sovereign and absolute in His reign. Wait on Him!

Next, we see God's <u>predetermined plan</u>—sent forth His Son. There isn't a moment of oscillation in our Heavenly Father's mind in sending His beloved Son, the second person of the Trinity to leave heaven's glory, to be robed in flesh and limited by His humanity, and function under the law, culture and political

confines. John writes in his Gospel, "All things were made by Him, and without Him was not anything made that was made." John 1:3. Can our minds ever fathom our Heavenly Father's profound depth of love and pain that comes with the separation? How heavy it must have been for Him to see the road of humiliation, suffering and sacrifice His Son Jesus ultimately have to face for our salvation sake (Phil 2: 6-8). Yet, our Lord's birth comes with a huge celebration and rightly so for finally, the Saviour has come, the many prophecies fulfilled and a promising Good News proclaimed to a lost and broken world.

How is the redeemer stepping into our world and taking the form of man? Here again, a <u>predetermined</u> <u>process</u> for our Saviour's birth. The prophet Isaiah, thousands of years ago prophesied that "Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a Son, and shall call His Name Immanuel..." Isaiah 7:14, "God with us..." Matt 1:23. Through a miraculous birth, without the human father factor, makes it possible for our Lord to be 100% unblemished human, thus, only Jesus could be our Lamb of God to take away the sins of the world (John 1:29).

Next, God's <u>predetermined placing</u> is "born under the [Old Testament] law." Jesus will fulfil the law perfectly (Matt 5:17), to be our perfect sacrifice of atonement and reconciliation through faith (Rom 3:25). Next, <u>predetermined privilege</u>, status and honour [sons] to all who will put their faith in Christ as their personal Saviour. Today, we are adopted as children of our Heavenly Father, through Christ, and with Christ as our firstborn (Rom 8:29d). Brethren, how can we not be overwhelmed by our Father's love, our Saviour's sacrifice, and our undeserving salvation? This Good News must be herald. Uphold in prayer our Christmas Gospel outreach next Saturday. Todate, we have 170 signed up where more than half are invited guests.
