Giving Of Our Best To The Lord

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 8 Dec 2024

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our
Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. The
well-known English missionary, who
persevered faithfully to serve the Lord in
China, India and Africa, once said, "Only one
life, 'twill soon be past, only what's done for
Christ will last. And when I am dying, how
happy I'll be, if the lamp of my life has been
burned out for Thee". When we reflect on the
above, and coming to the end of the year, how
has our life and service been for the Lord?

We are reminded of the different types and forms of work that we are given to serve God and others in and through the church, our families and society. 2 Tim. 4:5 "But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry". We are thus reminded and encouraged to put our full attention and effort to "accomplish it fully and whole-heartedly to its end, completing all its demands and requirements". In the end, we are not to do our best to prove ourselves and our abilities and capabilities, but to make full use of the gifts and talents that God has given and entrusted to each of us.

Giving of our best to our Master and Lord should be regardless of our age and stage of our lives. 2 Tim. 4:6 "For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand". It truly is a stark and grave reminder that at every moment of our lives, we are all to be always giving and doing our best for Him. This should not be only evident and clear in our individual Christian living, but also as each of us play our different roles and responsibilities in the local Body of Christ in Galilee Church. Each of us should always ask the important question of our thoughts, motivations and actions: whether they do help and contribute to the upkeeping and growing of Galilee Church

or not. Matt. 16:18 "And I [Jesus] say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it". As a church spanning across different generations, we as a Body of Christ would do well to understand and respect the different perspectives, opinions and actions, and have a spirit of collaboration to move Galilee Church forward.

In addition, Dr. Joseph Stowell who is a wellknown Christian author and Bible teacher, used Heb. 12:1-2 to highlight and bring out 2 other important pointers to help us run our Christian race well in this fallen and sinful world. First, we would do well to take notice of anything, such as material possessions, family ties, the love of comfort, that can become our priorities instead that of God, and to remove or reshape them with a God-honouring perspective. Second, if there be any sinful or self-centred motivation behind whatever we are doing, we would need to deal with it. This is needful as otherwise, our communion and fellowship with God would be blocked and become distorted. This would in turn cause our worship, prayers, study of His Word, and our service for Him to become mere religious motions and in vain [emptiness or worthlessness].

What are your thoughts regarding your Christian race? 2 Tim. 4:8 reminds us that God would surely reward us with the crown of righteousness. This crown of righteousness would be given to us who are 1) Faithful in using our gifts and opportunities in our Lord's service and 2) Loving Him and looking forward to His Second Coming or Appearing. May we be found faithful till the end of our Christian race.
