#### 'Tis The Season Of Giving Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 22 Dec 2024

eloved Brethren,

Blessed Christmas Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ as we remember His precious birth more than 2000 years ago. We are reminded of God's bountiful love and care for us in the sending of His Son to die on the Cross for our sin (John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life"). As we are grateful recipients of God's loving and saving grace, we who are in the current season of Christmas must not keep this Good News of salvation to ourselves but must always be prepared and willing to share it with others around us.

Yesterday, we were gathered for our annual Christmas Outreach event not merely among Galileans, but many newcomers and visitors were present to listen to the presentation of the Christmas Message. Our members and friends have certainly helped to pass the word around about our church programmes, and we are seeing the fruits of such efforts.
