Galileans, Build Up In Christ!

rethren. New Year Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! This year, as a church, by His grace, we commence or perhaps recommence in a more structured manner the SSG ministry at a church level. We labour in prayer and continuously persuade our members and friends to join a group that suits them well and grow in the faith. With Christ, who promised to build up our church, we will do our part to participate in His building project through SSG ministry and serve for the common wellbeing of our church. May God help us!

Paul wrote to encourage the Christian in Colosse. who were confronted with heresies and hardships that they may rise above their predicamernts and

do well in Christ. The church had to deal with elements of Jewish legalism. pagan mysticism, and early Gnostic thought, which suggested that spiritual knowledge was superior to faith. Then and now, the perils surrounding the church has not enervated over the ages. The "gates of hell" intensely seeks

to prevail against the church. Hence, Christ is our only refuge and strength against the perils of the church (Eph 6:12). Next, the reliable spiritual security of the church is the good grasp of the truth, and proper grounding in the Word of God. Any short fall in this area, all kinds of troubles will make our church as their conducive campsite. Therefore. intentionally, we have selected Colossians 2:7 as our Church Theme this year: "Rooted and built up in Him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving."

First, Paul encouraged the Christians to be "rooted and build up in Christ Jesus." Before, we came to Christ, we were rooted and build up in our own idiologies and beliefs that has been framed by our culture, communal norms, family dynamics and spiritual darkness. Now in Christ, we need to uproot over us attentively. Blessed New Year!

all such implants and impainations and recultivate our hearts and minds with the true knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Not some kind of superficial rootedness but one that is firmly and deeply rooted in Christ through the knowledge of God's Word. Here, our mind inevitably visits the writing of Psalm 1:2-3, "But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in His law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." As the Word saturated our hearts and minds, it will do its work of transformation that restores our fallenmind. remodels our hearts, revemps our ambitions and reconditions our motives and realigns our goals with kingdom priorities. In other words, we reflect

the image of Christ in our daily life, which is by the constitution of the scritpures and empowerment of the Holy Spirit.

The next process is to become established in the faith. Becoming strong in the faith. Though various

herecies were circulating the church, the false teachers were activie in their treacherous works. but the people remained steadfast in their faith. In stormy weather, only trees that have deep roots suvive the onslaught of the howling gales. Today, Christains are confronted with all kinds of heresies. half-truths, at workplaces, social circles and social media. Unless one is firmly rooted in the truth, there is much to lose for one's spiritual carelessness.

Lastly, Paul encourage the brethren to be grateful. Firstly, thank God in our country for the freedom to study God's Word freely and available conveniently through various agencies. Next, thank God for teachers and materials to educate oneslf in the truth to remain well in the faith. Last but not least, our Lord and Shepeherd Jesus Christ who watches
