# The Chief Shepherd's Voice!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 19 January 2025

Reteren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ! As the calendar turned and
ushered in the new year, we found ourselves
propelled into a whirlwind of activities and aspirations.
May the Lord give us all a fruitful year in Him, a joyful
year serving in His ministries, and make impressive
progress in everything our Lord committed to us.
Could these words simply amount to good wishful
thoughts or really be possible to realise in Him? Well,
it all counts on our intentional focus on Christ. We
ensure such a year for us by keeping in our hearts
what Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice, and I know
them, and they follow Me" John 10:27. Herein lies the
secret of our well-being.

"My sheep hears My voice"— In His church, we have two types of sheep. One type with well-tuned ears to its Shepherd's voice. While the other is intentionally or unintentionally insensitive to the voice of its shepherd. Our Lord Jesus underlines that every sheep of His flock can unmistakenly recognise His voice. In my reading for this article, I learnt that in the first century, a single sheep pen held multiple flocks, so it was essential for the sheep to know and recognize their own shepherd's voice. There had to be an unmistakable familiarity between sheep and shepherd for the sheep to feel safe and know which voice to follow. It can also be said undoubtedly, that a shepherd hears and recognises the cries of his sheep.

When encountering a challenging situation, we hear several voices from the various corners of our small world seeking to capture our attention. First, our own mind's voice counsels us as to how to go about with the circumstance. Other voices from family, friends and colleagues will voice convincingly to consider their assistance in our dilemma. But there is another important voice, the heavenly voice of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "He that hath ears to hear, let him hear" Matt 11:15. The ultimate counsel and guidance is our Lord's. While various voices swirling in our minds, it requires discipline and effort to decipher the right and promising voice of the Good Shepherd. The voice of the Lord is embedded in the eternal Word of

God. The Holy Spirit will bring to our mind, the Scriptures as to how to treat a situation, and how to evaluate the condition to make a decision that sits according to His Will. Paul writes to the Christians in Colosse in this same vein, "... we also...do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of His Will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that ye might walk worthy of the Lord..." 1:9-10a

"I know them" These words are absolutely comforting and assuring for me. First, the security of salvation. Many people know about Jesus, but Jesus knows them not (Matt 7:21-23). But we, undeserving of His mercies and grace, are marvellously known by our Lord and called us by our name (Is 45:4). This is a deliberate and intentional act effected even before the foundation of the world (Eph 1:4) and our names are written in the book of life (Phil 4:3). Next, no one can possibly know us so thoroughly as our Saviour Jesus Christ. David writes, "O lord, thou hast searched me and known me. Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways." Ps 139:1-3. His perfect knowledge invites us to come to Him simply as we are. He knows our complete makeup. Our trends of thoughts, our inclinations, and persuasions. Hence, we come before Him inline to the hymn, "Just as I am" in all sincerity and plainness.

"They follow Me" Herein lies the crucial point to do well this year. Follow Jesus faithfully. To veer from the Lord is an intentional invitation for many troubles. Again, voices here and there calling us to follow their ways and buy their proposals that may appear to be convincing, logical and pragmatic. Their offers may be very popular and proven with amiable results. However for us, we will utter "I will only follow the Lord and Him only!"
