Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 2 February 2025

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Thank God for a blessed time of renewing ties with relatives, friends, and fellow Galileans during the Lunar New Year celebration. Our rightful and purposeful prayer is that all of us do well as one people and serve harmoniously as one church to the glory of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. How? Pray!

Pray For Self — The Lord set us a great example in prayer. He spent much time, alone in prayer, before God the Father. "He went up into a mountain apart to pray and when the evening was come, He was there alone" (Mt 14:23). "And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, He went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed" (Mk 1:35). What did our Lord pray for? He would have prayed for His ministry and the challenges ahead for the day. He prayed for Himself as He progressed towards Calvary.

We too in our walk with the Lord will face a catalogue of temptations, troubles, and struggles as we seek to live out our faith in this broken world. As a responsible person, we toil over our various responsibilities to meet expectations to realise a rewarding life. In the same vein, we pray to the Lord to help us to be steadfast in our faith, grow in His Word, and remain devoted to the service of God. Pray for wisdom and strength to live well daily in the Lord.

Pray for Others — Our Lord prayed not only for Himself. He also interceded for His disciples. "The Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren" (Lk 22:31-32). John 17 is a classic chapter of our Lord praying for His disciples and the Church. We ought to pray for our loved ones, our brethren in the faith, unbelieving colleagues and friends as well. Let us not just pray for those with whom we can relate

well but also the "difficult" people God put in our lives. Prayer changes our perspective. Prayer helps to heal broken relationships and creates a magnanimous spirit within us when we pray for one another.

Pray for Desire for God's Word—At age 12, our Lord showed much interest in the things of God as He sat "in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them and asking them questions. And all that heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers" (Lk 2:46-47). Later, as He began His ministry, "the people were astonished at His doctrine: For He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes" (Mt 7:28-29). We need to know God's Word well so that we can apply His Word in life situations aptly, share the Gospel with others confidently and catechise others in the Holy Scriptures. His Word helps us rise above the daily grind of life. God's Word sets us on the right path and guides us through all our decisions and actions. As a church we strive to be rooted in Christ, and His Word firmly. The accurate knowledge of God's Word is the fundamental protective armour against the spiritual adversaries of the church (Eph 6:10-18).

Pray For A Serving Heart —"Jesus saith... My meat is to do the Will of Him that sent Me, and to finish His work" (Jn 9:4). "I must work the works of Him that sent Me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work" (Jn 4:34). The Lord did the Father's business with a great sense of urgency and devotion. Likewise, let us serve God with the right attitude and mindset. Never trivialise our tasks in His kingdom but treat them as God-given blessed opportunities. Worship God through our Works! While our breath abides, we abide actively in God's service. The Heavenly Father's business is our business. Let's serve God diligently, gladly, fervently, faithfully, and jointly with one another. This year, with God's help, Galileans will do well in the Lord, grow in His Word, and flourish in His works. God Bless!
