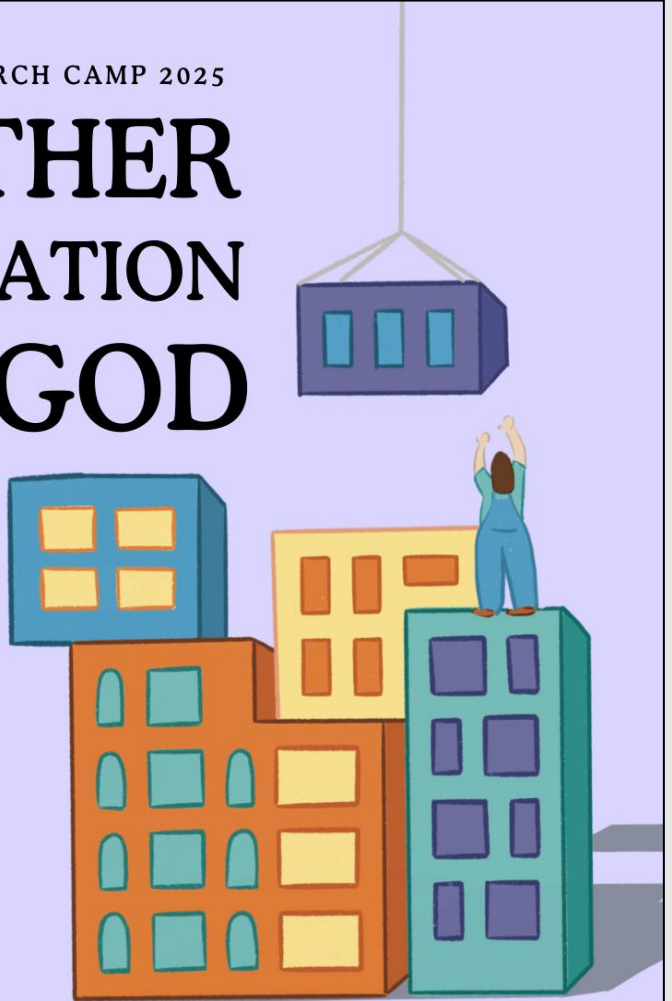

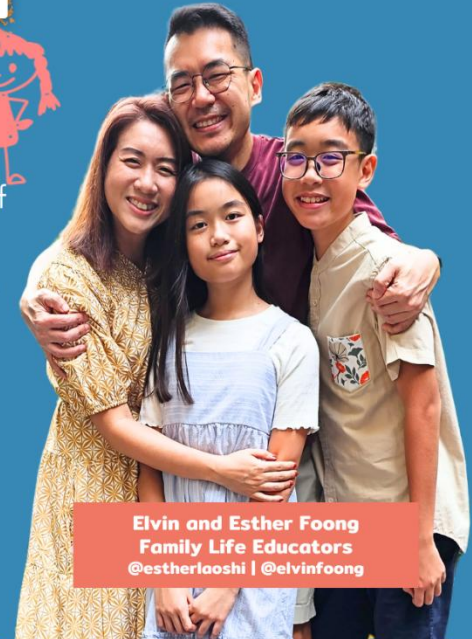

When God Shows Up

Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 23 Feb 2025

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Since the year has started, have you encountered and experienced unexpected surprises, and twists and turns? When we experience such predicaments, we can be easily distracted and get caught up in the chaos. Are you then able to remind yourself to quieten your soul, and find your sacred time and space with God?

It is surely so important for us to have a sufficient and good Quiet Time in God's Word and prayer as we need to allow God's voice to speak to us amidst the myriad of other voices. This is to allow God's grace to speak warmly to us and to catch a glimpse of His loving work in our lives. We are reminded of this from Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose." When we are tempted to question God, His grace, and His purposes in our lives, let us look back at such moments of His grace to realise that He has not forsaken or left us, especially in our darkest moments. Our God is faithful and He keeps His promises to us.

When we open our hearts to God and to His grace, we will not have a limited and narrowed human perspective on the happenings in our lives. Instead, we would gradually grow to understand and adopt the divine perspective (Isaiah 55:8-9 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, saith the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts"). Placing ourselves in His Divine Presence would enable us to be renewed and transformed in Him. Through them, we can grow to offer to God our

hearts, our thoughts, and our desires, and seek for Him to redefine, rework, redirect, and sanctify us, so that we can be used to fulfil His Will and Purposes. Every part of our lives, from the smallest to the biggest struggle can be used to refine us and make us more like Him.

Since God is faithful in our lives, what is our response to Him? What is the picture of our lives as compared to the bigger picture of God's Work and Purposes in our world? May I point out to each of us that we are to walk in obedience and faith in God. We should be encouraged by the Old Testament examples as listed in Hebrews Chapter 11: Abel, Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, and Rahab. What do the journeys of all these individuals' obedience and faith include and necessitate? All of them persevered in uncertainty, trusting in God's Sovereignty and provision, even when the outcome was unclear. They also overcame their fears and doubts by relying on or going back to their faith in God and His Promises, especially when they faced humanly impossible and insurmountable odds and obstacles. Ultimately, they all lived always with an eternal perspective in view (Heb. 11:10 "For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God").

Let us allow God to always have His fingerprints and workings in our lives, and not leave Him out. Let us give Him first priority in our hearts, and include Him in every single area of our lives. We would then experience the increased inner joy and peace in Him. Isaiah 26:3 "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee". God Bless!
