rethren. Greetings in the Name of our Lord & Saviour, Jesus Christ! Our Lord directs us, "But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you" Matt 6:33. In Latin, the word "prioritas" means, (prior-first) the condition of coming before something else in time or importance. We have loads of things to do which demand plenty of attention and tax resources yet we only have limited time, strength, and means. Hence, the need to prioritise becomes critical. Do you realize that the Holy Bible is a book of priorities - to teach and guide us toward loving God, obeying Him and living a life profitably not only for now but with effects that transcend beyond this earthly life? "And I heard a voice from heaven saving unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours: and their works do follow them" Rev 14.13

Direction to the right destination is vital. When we are driving with GPS aiding us, from time to time we take a glance at the device to ensure we are in the right direction while listening to the conversation or radio in the car. The GPS we have in our hearts and minds is God's Word to ensure that we are on the right track in life. Psalmist writes, "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." Ps 119:105. We need to constantly examine where our life is going and whether our priorities and life goals are in sync with God's will and purpose.

Our Lord Jesus taught vital PRIORITIES in the Christian's life (John 21:15-19). Let's see how Jesus tenderly restored a very discouraged and disheartened Peter in a heart-to-heart talk. Walking with the Lord is not a stroll in the park. Practising the precepts of the Holy God in a fallen and broken world is not like sipping a cup of coffee. It is very challenging and even heart-wrenching. Amid attractions and distractions, trials and temptations, opportunities and oppressions we need a keen sense of direction. The very ground we stand on is infested with thorns and thistles, bugs and vipers. We know what Peter did

when he ran into a life-threatening situation. He didn't think he smartly got out of danger but anguished within for a while at the fireplace. God comforts us when we wabble in our walk and puts us back on our feet to follow Him.

PRIORITY 1: "Lovest thou Me?" (Jn 21:15). This was Jesus' gentle prompt to Peter to re-align his heart to love the Lord supremely and be exclusively devoted to his Master and Saviour. What would be our response to this vital question? Devotional writer Sidlow Baxter pens it so correctly: "The first thing which makes a true minister or missionary or evangelist or preacher or Sunday School teacher or Christian worker of any kind, is not learning, not eloquence, not wisdom, not organizing ability, not pleasing personality, not even a 'passion of souls', but a love-passion of Jesus Himself. Nothing, nothing, nothing can take the place of that. All else without that is like withered flowers". The Christian's paramount duty is to love the Lord supremely with an undivided heart. Jesus said, "... Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment" (Mk 12:30). It will do us well to take periodic "heart-checks" and conscientiously work at re-ordering our lives to grow in a loving, intimate relationship with the Lord.

Next, PRIORITY 2: "Follow Me" (Jn 21:19). Our Lord was reminding His Disciple Peter to fix his eyes on Jesus Himself and follow Him. A faithful servant of the Lord is an obedient and humble follower of Jesus. We are reminded here that we are not to live as we please, not to follow our feelings and experiences, not to shift our loyalty away from Christ to follow after men, not to practise blindly the traditions of culture or the norms of society that are not in line with the teaching and counsel of God's Word, not to seek after the philosophies and wisdom of the world that go contrary to the practice of our faith in Jesus Christ. We are to follow only the Great Shepherd, Our Lord, and Master Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "if you love me keep My commandments" (Jn 14:15).

May God help us!
