Having Our Focus on Christ Rev David Cher, Lord's Day, 13 April 2025

Beloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We are living in a chaotic and ever-changing world with surprises, twists and turns that can leave us feeling uncertain and unsure of what's next. It is only in Christ who transcends the ups and downs of life that would give us the constant sense of hope and purpose for our lives. Living in Christian community would further strengthen as we encourage and support one another especially in our seasons of struggles.

Let us ensure that Christ is the center or heart of our faith whether as individual followers of Christ, or as a corporate Body of Christ, the church. Christ is the One that we build our faith upon. We should thus train our minds to not be distracted by the concerns, worries, and fears, but refocus them on Christ. This would mean that we are not immune to the uncertainties and worries of life, but surrendering them to Christ. He is the One who has called us, saved us, and given us new life. As Colossians 3:3 says, " For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God." The phrase "your life is hid with Christ in God" means that we can have a deep, intimate, and secure relationship and connection to Christ.

Let us also not be weighed down and taken away by sin (Heb. 12:1-2). Let us be reminded that we are new creatures in Christ (2 Cor. 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new"). Thus, we are to move away from sin and toward Christ, which is also known as daily repentance (1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness"). We should realise that focusing on Christ is not merely a spiritual,

mystical, and emotional experience, but one that is also practically lived out in our lives.

"As the Living Word of God (John 1:1), Christ guides us through Scripture, which reveals His truth and wisdom. We are called to dwell in His Word (Col. 3:16). "Dwelling" in God's Word means that His Word would be constantly in our minds and hearts guiding our thoughts, feelings, and actions, even when we are doing well. We are also to allow His Word to penetrate deep into our hearts and minds, shaping our identity in Christ. When we have internalised His Word, we can live it out in practical ways, teaching and admonishing one another with all wisdom.

Living in Christ's sufficiency means that we recognise that His strength, power, and wisdom are more than enough for every situation we face. This means that we must first recognize our limitations, in that we don't have all the answers and that we can't fix every problem on our own. We can and should turn to Christ and rely on His strength. When we rely on Christ's strength, we we will be empowered to face challenges with confidence, to overcome obstacles, and to accomplish tasks that seemed impossible, through this, God helps us develope humility and dependence on Him.

With our minds and hearts focused on Christ, we will then experience the inner peace from God that will govern and guide us through difficult and perplexing circumstances, whether as individauls or as a church. This peace from God will always remain with us, in clear contrast to the temporal external peace only associated with smooth-going periods in our lives (John 14:27). We are all invited to place ourselves into God's loving and caring arms (1 Peter 5:7).

May God bless us as we journey together in faith!
